1. RULES:

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008, including Appendix D, the prescriptions of US SAILING, the ISSA Procedural Rules, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

- 2.1. Competing schools must be members in good standing of MISSA and meet ISSA eligibility rules as prescribed in the Procedural Rules.
- 2.2. Teams must be accompanied by a designated adult team leader, who may be an advisor, coach or parent recognized by the school.

3. ENTRY AND COMMUNICATIONS:

- 3.1. Eligible schools and sailors must enter by submitting an official entry form and two separate checks, one for entry fee, and one for boat damage deposit, with the regatta chairperson by April 25, 2008.

4. ENTRY FEE:

- 4.1. The entry is \$275.00 per school. This includes continental breakfast, lunch, Crescent's "Taco Bar", after Saturday racing for 6 team members and coach. Additional team members, team leaders, coaches and parents can buy additional meal packages for \$30 each.

5. DAMAGE DEPOSIT:

- 5.1. A damage deposit of \$200.00 must be submitted with each entry. This is refundable if the boat and gear are returned undamaged. In the event damage cannot be attributed to a particular team, the repair costs will be divided evenly amongst all the competing teams.

6. BOATS:

6.1. Collegiate 420's, provided by Crescent Sail Yacht Club.

6.2. Boats shall be sailed as provided.

7. SCHEDULE:

Friday, May 2, 2008

1700-1900 Registration at CSYC.

Saturday, May 3, 2008

0800 – 0930 Continental breakfast at CSYC and last-minute registration. Rig boats.

0930 Competitors Meeting – MANDATORY.
Starting time for first race will be announced at Competitors Meeting;
sailing will continue throughout the day.

Sunday, May 4, 2008

0830-0900 Continental breakfast. Rig boats.

0900 Competitors Meeting – MANDATORY.
Starting time for first race will be announced at Competitors Meeting;
sailing will continue throughout the day.

1500 NO RACE will be started after this time.

1700 Awards Presentation.

7.1. Any changes to the schedule will be posted on the Official Notice Board located at CSYC.

8. RACING AREA:

8.1. All races will be sailed on Lake St. Clair, to the East of CSYC.

9. COURSES:

9.1. Based on conditions, the Race Committee will determine the courses as prescribed in ISSA PR 7.7.

10. SCORING:

10.1. The regatta will be scored in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules.

11. HOUSING:

11.1. Limited housing is available on a first come, first served basis. A list of hotels is included on this NOR.

12. TRAVEL AND TRANSPORTATION:

12.1. Teams are responsible for their own transportation.

13. COACHING:

13.1. Team leaders, chaperones, coaches, parents, advisors and other support personnel shall not go afloat in the sailing area from the end of registration Friday to the end of racing Sunday unless explicitly permitted by the regatta chairperson. The penalty for

failing to comply with this requirement may be the disqualification of all boats, competitors and teams associated with the infringing support personnel.

- 13.2.** Competitors, who have notified the Race Committee of their intent to file a protest, shall not communicate with coaches or anyone else while preparing and filing protest forms and preparing for the hearing.

14. PRIZES:

14.1. Prizes will be awarded to schools placing 1st, 2nd and 3rd in the regatta.

15. OFFICIAL NOTICE:

No contestant shall use, either on or off the water, alcoholic beverages (beer, wine, or distilled spirits, each as defined in Chap 51 of the US Internal Revenue Code and intended for beverage use), or marijuana, cocaine, or any other controlled substance (as defined in 21 US Code 802), the possession of which, by that contestant is unlawful under 21 US Code 841.

Infringements of this regulation and/or other discipline expectations occurring during May 2-4, 2008, may be the basis for a hearing under RRS 69.1. The protest committee for such a hearing shall be the regatta chairperson, a member of the ISSA BOD, and the protest committee chairperson. This protest committee shall, at a time and place selected by them, meet to hear said protest, and their decision to impose scoring penalties, or other sanctions they alone deem appropriate, including summary removal from the regatta, shall be final, without appeal.
