- 1. RULES:** The regatta will be governed by the 2005-2008 Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association, the Interscholastic Sailing Association Procedural Rules, the I.O.D.A. class rules, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.

- 2. BOATS:** 420's & International Optimist Dinghies. A number of 420's are available for charter on a first come, first served basis. Priority will be given to out of state teams. **And teams are required to bring their own sails.** Interested teams should contact Joe Harris at 847-615-7474.

- 3. SAFETY:** Competitors, coaches, advisors, and parents while afloat must wear US Coast Guard Type III or higher PFD (Life Jacket) during the regatta. 4.2. PFDs must be worn **OUTSIDE** all apparel (including but not limited to splash guards and drysuits) except sleeveless rash guards used to prevent snags in rigging or improve team/school identification

- 4. ELIGIBILITY:** Competing Varsity High School Teams or Clubs must be members of the Midwest Interscholastic Sailing Association and the Interscholastic Sailing Association. No student below the level of 9th grade shall be eligible to compete in the HS Fleet. Teams must be accompanied by an adult advisor, parent, or coach. There will be a JV fleet if we have enough interest, ad-hoc teams would be eligible in this fleet. The cut off would be 7th grade. Optimist sailors must adhere to Optimist class rules for competition.

- 5. ENTRY:** Entry deadline will be Friday, October 19, 2007.

- 8. SCORING:** The regatta will be scored in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules. All completed races shall be counted.
- 9. NUMBER OF RACES:** At least one race must be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 10. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** Sailing Instructions will be available at 0800 on the morning of the first race.
